Inter-campus exchange programme

University of Nottingham Ningbo China (UNNC)

Application deadline

Friday 7 February 2020

Eligibility

BArch (K100) Architecture MEng (K230) Architecture and Environmental Design BEng (K240) Architectural Environment Engineering students

55% average required to be considered, 10 places available per year. BArch and BEng students apply in first year to study abroad for the spring semester of second-year.

MEng students apply in their second year to study abroad for either the full year, spring semester or autumn semester of their third-year.

University-wide exchange programme

Application deadline

Friday 10 January 2020

Eligibility

BArch Students (K100): Apply in first-year to study abroad for the spring semester of second-year OR apply in fourth- year (whilst on your year out) to study abroad for the autumn semester of fifth year.

MEng Students (K230): Apply in second-year to study abroad for the spring semester of third-year OR apply in fifth-year (whilst on your year out) to study abroad for the autumn semester of sixth-year.

BEng Students (K240): Apply in the first-year for exchange in either the autumn or spring semester of second-year.

Minimum 60% average required to be considered.
