Features of KTP

Government funded scheme with a proven track record built over 35 years Budget ~ £65K pa, 67% Grant for SMEs, 50% for large businesses

Projects are 6 months to 3 years in length and should be of strategic importance to the company partner

The project is managed by a graduate (KTP Associate) who is jointly recruited by the university and the company partner.

Graduate is employed by the university but is located at the business premises

Academic Supervisor spends around half day per week with the Associate at company premises





Project Criteria

Project should be innovative and strategically relevant to the business

Company should be financially stable and show high growth potential

Senior management/board support for the project

Sound business case and demonstrate impact and commercial return

Stimulating and challenging for the Academic team

External knowledge and input essential

Clear knowledge transfer with benefits likely to accrue
