International University, Vietnam National University Ho Chi Minh City Partnership Scholarship

The University of Nottingham is delighted to announce a number of partial scholarships for new students from The International University, Vietnam National University, Ho Chi Minh City, registering on Undergraduate Degree programmes at The University of Nottingham's UK campus in September 2012 in the following Schools or Departments

- Biosciences
- Computer Science
- Electrical and Electronic Engineering

For students in the School of Biosciences

All students registering on degree programmes in the School of Biosciences will receive an automatic £1,000 tuition fee scholarship, reducing the normal international tuition fee from £15,720 annually to £14,720 annually.

For students in the School of Computer Science

The top two students who exceed the academic conditions of an offer which the School of Computer Science sets them, or who receive an unconditional offer which is seen to exceed the typical academic criteria during the standard UCAS application round, registering on degree programmes in the School of Computer Science, and remaining registered until 1 December 2012, will receive an automatic £2,000 tuition fee scholarship, reducing the first year normal international tuition fee from £15,720 to £13,720. This scholarship is only available for the first year in the UK.

Based on their performance in Part I, students whose average performance is ranked within the top 10 results in the School will also be eligible for a further scholarship of £2,000 to be issued at the start of Part II. This scholarship is open to all Computer Science students taking Part I studies in the UK

For students in the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering

All students registering on a BEng or MEng degree programme in the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering will receive an automatic £1,500 tuition fee scholarship. If you receive the award in your first year (2012) you will also be entitled to £1,500 for the second and any subsequent years of the undergraduate programme, conditional upon you passing the previous year with an overall average of 55% or above and having satisfactory attendance during the previous year as determined by the head of department.
