The 2nd Annual Conference of the PSA Contemporary Aristotelian Studies Group (CAS) will take place at The Helmsley (Staff Club), University of Nottingham, on Wednesday, 18th July, 2012.

The academic convenors for the Conference are Dr. Tony Burns, Co-Director of the Centre for the Study of Social and Global Justice (CSSGJ), in the School of Politics & International Relations at the University of Nottingham and Dr. Kelvin Knight, Director of the Centre for Contemporary Aristotelian Studies in Ethics and Politics (CASEP) at London Metropolitan University.

Papers relating to any aspect of contemporary Aristotelian studies are welcome. E.g. Aristotle and Continental Political Thought; Aristotle and Critical Theory; Aristotle and Poststructuralism; Aristotle and Political Ideologies; Aristotle and Natural Rights; Aristotle and Cosmopolitanism; Aristotle and hermeneutics; Aristotle and Gadamer; Aristotle and Heidegger, Aristotle and Education; Aristotle and Management; Aristotle and Utopianism, etc., etc.

Proposals from postgraduate research students are welcome.

All proposals should include a title, an abstract, and some brief biographical information (name, title, current status, degrees awarded, awarding institution, date, publications).

The final deadline for submission of proposals is **30th April, 2012**. Early submissions are preferred.

Participants may also be interested in attending or presenting at the 6th Annual Conference of the International Society for MacIntyrean Enquiry (ISME), which is scheduled to take place at the same venue from Thursday 19th July to Saturday 21st July, 2012.
