PhD project

This project integrates socio-economic and ecological analysis of land use policies, focusing on the design of 'realistic' policy tools that can help to deliver multiple and spatially heterogeneous objectives at the landscape scale by including stakeholders participation in that process.

Landscapes are heterogeneous with respect to the services (e.g. biodiversity, recreation) they could deliver, the potential costs of enhancing this delivery and the feasibility of achieving effective delivery through market-based mechanisms. This poses a real challenge to policy: established EU agri-environment schemes are poorly suited to deal with scale, heterogeneity or the need to operate at the multiple farms level. As part of my research land managers' cooperation is investigated as a possible solution to tackle this problem.
