In support of the University's wider internationalization strategy and to support diversity of our student body, 25% tuition fee scholarships are available for students who complete a degree programme from the Faculty of Engineering at The University of Nottingham's Malaysia campus and register on a Taught Masters course in the Faculty of Engineering at The University of Nottingham's UK campus in September 2009 – Departments of Chemical and Environmental Engineering, Civil Engineering, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, and Mechanical, Materials and Manufacturing Engineering (excluding the distance learning MSc in Power Electronics, Machines and Drives).

According to RAE 2008 data (Research Assessment Exercise), 97% of research in engineering at The University of Nottingham is of international quality, with over 75% defined as 'world-leading' or 'internationally excellent'. The RAE results place us firmly in the UK's top five universities for engineering.

In order to receive one of these scholarships you must

- be a graduate of The University of Nottingham (Malaysia campus)
- be holding a conditional or unconditional offer of a place on a full time Taught Masters degree programme in the Faculty of Engineering at The University of Nottingham from September 2009
- be classified as an 'overseas' student for fee purposes
- **complete an online application form after you register on your course in September 2009**

How to apply

- Application forms for the above scholarship will be available at http://www.international/scholarships_and_finance/scholarships/_non-comp-schols-index.php after registration in September 2009 – you must have registered on your programme in September 2009 to be eligible to apply
 - The scholarship is given once an application form has been completed and satisfactory evidence of previous successfully completed study at The University of Nottingham has been provided. The scholarship will be refunded to the fee payer
