## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **The host university I wish to study at is not listed on my School flyer. Am I still able to study there?**

For the Universitas 21/University-wide programme, the choice of host university and period of study abroad is determined by each participating School based upon compatible modules at the host university. Not all host universities are suitable destinations for your School. If you feel that a particular host university offers interesting and compatible modules but is not on the list for your School, then please discuss this directly with your School Coordinator.

For a student to participate in the Erasmus programme to any university there must be a valid exchange agreement in place between your School at Nottingham and the relevant School in a partner university. If this does not exist you are not able to study at that university.

- **I am not in the correct year to apply. What should I do?**

Your School selects the most appropriate period of time for their students to study abroad, taking into consideration the structure and requirements of the degree programme. It is therefore unlikely that you will be able to study abroad at any other point during your degree.

- **How do I apply to study abroad?**

For the Erasmus programme, please contact your School for further information. - **What if I am selected for the exchange but do not perform well in the end of year exams?**

Your nomination to study abroad is always dependent on your continued successful academic progression at Nottingham. Your School reserves the right to cancel your exchange before you depart if they are concerned about your academic performance and progression.

- **Is there any financial assistance available?**
