About the study

People who live in care homes are at great risk of falling. Falls are common, harmful, costly, and difficult to prevent. The Action Falls programme (formally GtACH) trains and supports care home staff to identify the reasons why residents fall and then guides them to complete Actions to reduce falls. In a large multicentre randomised controlled trial called the FinCH trial, the Action Falls programme was cost-effective and reduced falls by 43%. We are now researching how to deliver the Action Falls programme in 'real life' outside a research trial.

What we have accomplished so far

In December 2022 we reached our recruitment target of **60** care home across our **4** sites.

Training **50%** of care home staff (all roles) in the Action Falls programme is well underway.

Action Falls Collaborative events (AFC's), are continuing across all sites; bringing the care homes in the study together discussing Action Falls.

Feedback about the intervention continues to be collected and analysed using various collection methods such as the NoMAD questionnaires, 1:1 interviews, peer support meetings, AFC event observations, focus groups, stakeholder and study steering group meetings.
