Research update from Jenny Ashworth - recipient of an NBCRC Pilot Grant award in 2021



Last month, I presented initial data from my NBCRC pilot grant project at an international virtual event: "The Structural Microenvironment: Breaking down the walls of cancer". The theme was to explore how tumours interact with the cells and tissue around them, and I had the chance to discuss my early work studying the role of tumour cell surroundings in breast cancer progression.
