
# NBCRC Breast Cancer awareness events in October

Jenny says "The NBCRC pilot grant was hugely helpful to me in demonstrating my research independence and I'm sure it made a big difference to my application"

Jenny has developed a model of breast cancer fibrosis which will allow her to screen patient tumour cells and predict which have the greatest risk of invading and causing metastasis.
