

NATIONAL STUDENT SURVEY RESULTS FOR HISTORY AND ARCHAEOLOGY AT NOTTINGHAM

During the 2005-2006 undergraduates studying History and Archaeology at the University of Nottingham took part in the National Student Survey. Below are the results obtained by History and Archaeology at Nottingham for two of the key indicators: student evaluation of teaching at and overall satisfaction with their chosen course.

Category responses are shown in a scale of 1 (definitely disagree) to 5 (definitely agree) with the average response provided. Broadly speaking the higher the average, the greater the level of student satisfaction.
