

Prize Draw Terms and Conditions – University of Nottingham

These terms and conditions apply to the National Student Survey (“NSS”) prize draw for eligible students as detailed below. The NSS is operated and managed by Ipsos . If you wish to be considered for the prize draw, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions with the University.

Eligibility

1. The prize draw is open to final year undergraduate students who meet the eligibility requirements set out at <https://www.thestudentsurvey.com/faqs/> (“Students”).
2. For the avoidance of doubt, the prize draw is not open to employees of the University, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the prize draw.
3. The University reserves the right to refuse entry or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

Entry to the prize draw

4. Students can opt into the prize draw upon completion of the NSS online survey via the [NSS website](#)
5. You acknowledge that the University has no control over the NSS website and we will not be responsible in any way for it. Further, by accessing the NSS website you will be subject to a separate privacy notice and other applicable terms of Ipsos. We strongly recommend that you review NSS website’s privacy notice and applicable terms before completing the survey and entering the prize draw.
6. The prize draw is free to enter, non-compulsory and no purchase is necessary.
7. A maximum of one entry per person is permitted for the prize draw. However, this prize draw may run concurrently to other NSS prize draws of the University, its schools and faculties, and Students may therefore be eligible for entry into more than one prize draw upon completion of the NSS.
8. The opening date for entries is Wednesday 11 January.
9. The closing date for entries is 23.59 on Sunday 30 April. Entries received after this time will not be considered.

Administration of the prize draw

10. The prize draw will take place up to five working days after the prize draw closing date by random draw performed by a computer process.
11. The decision of the University (or Ipsos on the University’s behalf) regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
12. The University must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation, the University will send the surname and county of the prize winners to anyone who e-mails studentcommsoffice@exmail.nottingham.ac.uk within one month of the survey closing date. If you object to any of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please contact studentcommsoffice@exmail.nottingham.ac.uk. Notwithstanding,

you acknowledge and agree that the University may be legally required to disclose such information to the Advertising Standards Authority or other relevant body upon request.

13. The University reserves the right to delay, void, cancel, suspend or amend the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so.

Prize award

14. 3 winners will be chosen in accordance with paragraph 10 above.
15. Each winner will receive 1x £500 Love to shop digital voucher.
17. Each winner will receive their digital vouchers via their University email address no later than 10 working days after the prize draw. Each prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.
18. The University reserves the right to replace a prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the University's control make it necessary to do so.

Liability

21. The University accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure of any kind.
22. Insofar as is permitted by law, the University, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate any winner or accept any liability for any loss damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of a winner taking up the prize, except where it is caused by the negligence of the University, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

Personal data

23. Personal data supplied during the course of the survey and prize draw will be processed in accordance with Ipsos' privacy notice, for which the University is not in any way responsible for (see paragraph 5 above). Personal data used for administering of the prizes will be processed by the University in accordance with the [University's privacy notice](#). See also paragraph 12 above with regard to announcement of winners. You are under no obligation to provide your personal data but if you fail to do so neither Ipsos nor the University may be able to administer your submission to the NSS nor your entry to the prize draw.

Governing law

24. The prize draw will be governed by the laws of England & Wales and entrants to the prize draw submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of England & Wales.
