Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to the prize draw for students of the University of Nottingham ("the University") participating in the Postgraduate Student Experience Survey ("PTES"). If you wish to be considered for the prize draw, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

Eligibility

- 1. The prize draw is open to postgraduate taught students at the University aged 18 years and over who are eligible to take part in PTES. ("students").
- 2. For the avoidance of doubt, the prize draw is not open to employees of the University, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the prize draw.
- 3. The University reserves the right to refuse entry or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

Prize draw

- 4. All eligible students will automatically be entered into the prize draw in accordance with our <u>Privacy Information for Students and Applicants</u>. Anyone who does not wish to be entered into the prize draw should contact hannah.sherwood@nottingham.ac.uk before 20 May 2022.
- 5. The prize draw is free to enter, non-compulsory and no purchase is necessary.
- 6. A maximum of one entry per person is permitted for the prize draw.
- 7. The opening date for entries is Monday 11 April 2022.
- 8. The closing date for entries is Friday 13 May 2022. Entries received after this time will not be considered.

Administration of the prize draw

- 9. The prize draw will take place on 20 May 2022 by random draw performed by a computer. This process will be carried out by the University.
- 10. The decision of the University regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
- 11. The University must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation, the University will send the surname and county of the prize winners to anyone who e-mails hannah.sherwood@nottingham.ac.uk within one month of the survey closing date (Friday 13 May 2022). If you object to any of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please contact hannah.sherwood@nottingham.ac. In such circumstances, the University must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.
- 12. The University reserves the right to delay, void, cancel, suspend or amend the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so.

Winner of prize draw

- 13. Two winners will be chosen in accordance with the process and on the date set out at paragraph 8 above.
- 14. Each winner will receive vouchers to the value of £200.
- 15. The winners will be notified by e-mail (using their university email address) by 27 May 2022.
- 16. If a winner does not respond to the University within 7 days of being notified by the University, then that winner's prize will be forfeited and the University will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.

17. Each winner will receive their vouchers via their preferred email address.

The prizes

- 18. Each prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.
- 19. The University reserves the right to replace a prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the University's control make it necessary to do so.

Liability

- 20. The University accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault, technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure of any kind.
- 21. Insofar as is permitted by law, the University, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate any winner or accept any liability for any loss damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of a winner taking up the prize, except where it is caused by the negligence of the University, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

Personal data

22. Personal data supplied during the course of the promotion will only be processed as set out in the University's <u>privacy notice</u>. See also paragraph 11 above with regard to announcement of winners.

Governing law

23. The prize draw will be governed by English law and entrants to the prize draw submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts.
