

## **Feedback from Student Videos**

### **Video 1**

I haven't been able to get involved in the sports at the University as the David Ross Sports Centre membership is really expensive. The sports societies require you to have membership of the David Ross Sports Centre for you to take part in them so I therefore can't participate.
