- Email: When sending messages to large groups, use bcc rather than cc. In text box of message make 'circulation' list explicit and key points clear
- Email: Reduce the amount of information included in email signatures, particularly internal messages / get rid of footers, including legal information. If necessary add a link to this
- Web: Have a single point of contact to add 'page broken'
- Web: Add single page of links to information with useful email addresses for key issues (informed by [text redacted] that this is happening)
- Web: Ensure there is a phone contact for each department/service area

The consultation document explains that in these turbulent times we need to consider new and radical ideas. If you have a radical idea you would like to suggest, please tell us here.

- A significant investment in a Wellbeing Centre is needed for both staff and students (similar in scope and size of David Ross Sports Centre)
- Increase in, and improvement of, teaching space
- Decentralise all services (e.g. Student services and IS)
- Have a clear objective on 'excellence' such as staying in the global top 100 universities (careful consideration of criteria rather than aiming for one single measure)
- Doing something distinctive to specifically attract and retain top overseas (European and International) talent
- Consider radically different ways of delivering teaching (non-lecture based)
