In a sentence, how would you describe the purpose of the University of Nottingham?

Overall Mission & Purpose:

- Advancing knowledge (encompasses research and teaching) – Education
- Be braver about the complexity of learning and that as a student here you will be challenged. We will help you navigate the complexity but we won't simplify it.
- Creating new knowledge.
- Developing 'knowledge workers'.
- Protective space for researchers and teaching that isn't always about responding to the latest issues. - Freedom, independence.
- Need to strategically set own vision and if done well REF,TEF will take care of itself - Enables us to be distinctive in current era.
- Rebutting the discourse of being the best at everything – more about quality than relative status

What sort of growth, if any, should we aim for?

Growth:

- Quality not quantity.
- More work with the community.
- Work with FE.
- Reach out to 'difficult' communities – e.g. Mansfield
- Target growth on diversity – avoid elitism.
- Planned and strategic growth.
- Helping students from different backgrounds to not feel alienated.
- Relationship with the city and the local community.
- Grow as a better university not a bigger university.
- Currently too much emphasis is on global and emphasis on local is not as apparent/explicit as it could be.
- Look after part-time students more and the local community.
- Reclaim a stronger presence in the local community
