## University-wide exchange programme

### Application deadline

Friday 11 January 2019

### Eligibility

Apply in first-year to study abroad for autumn semester of your second-year. Minimum 60% average required to be considered. BA Economics and Philosophy students must ensure that the relevant Philosophy modules are offered, and work with the Department of Philosophy to finalise their study plan. Students taking PPE should consult with both Politics and Philosophy to see if the appropriate modules are available at their chosen destination from the list of approved School of Economics partners.

Friday 8 February 2019

Students taking the Quantitative Economics stream in year two (except BA Economics with French/German/Spanish/Russian). Apply in first-year to study abroad for the spring semester of second-year. It is not possible to study abroad both through the University-wide programme and at the Malaysia Campus or China Campus.
