University of Nottingham Malaysia (UNM)

Application deadline

Friday 7 February 2020

Eligibility

BEng students: Apply in first-year to study abroad for full-year of second- year.

MEng students: Apply in first-year to study abroad for full-year of second-year OR apply in second-year to study abroad for full-year of third-year.

Study abroad during second-year: open to all courses, however Electronic and Computing Engineering students will take the Electrical component of the Practical Engineering Design Solutions and Project Development module, rather than the Computing component.

Study abroad during third-year: open to all courses, except for Electronic and Computing Engineering, students on this course are not eligible for exchange in their third-year

55% average required to be considered.

For some courses there may be a restricted range of optional modules.

University of Nottingham Ningbo China (UNNC)

Application deadline

Friday 7 February 2020

Eligibility

BEng/MEng: Apply in first-year to study abroad for full-year of second-year.

Open to all courses, however Electronic and Computing Engineering students will take the Electrical component of the Practical Engineering Design Solutions and Project Development module, rather than the Computing component.

55% average required to be considered.

Eligibility

BEng students: Apply in first-year to study abroad for full-year of second-year.

MEng students: Apply in first-year to study abroad for full-year of second-year OR apply in second-year to study abroad for full-year of third-year. Exchange in third-year is subject to the student finding a suitable individual project at the partner and having it pre-agreed with the partner.

Minimum 60% average required to be considered.
