Application deadline

Friday 11 January 2019

Eligibility

Apply in first year to study abroad for autumn semester or spring semester of second year. Minimum 60% average required to be considered. Open to both single and joint honours students; joint honours students must check with their other school/department to ensure that staff approve the exchange and programme of study.

For exchanges in autumn semester, northern hemisphere destination are preferred and for exchanges in spring semester southern hemisphere destinations are preferred.
