Eligibility

BA History, BA History with Chinese Studies, BA History and Politics only. Apply in first-year to study abroad for the autumn semester/ full-year/spring semester of the second-year. Minimum 55% average required to be considered.

Erasmus exchange programme

For students from the Department of History only.

Eligibility

Apply in first-year to study abroad for autumn semester or spring semester of second-year. Open to both single and joint honours students; joint honours students must check with their other school/department to ensure that staff approve the exchange and programme of study. Students will require good competence in German or French respectively to be eligible for consideration.

Application deadline

Deadlines depend on the University you are applying to. Please enquire as far in advance as possible. Grants and other financial matters have their own deadlines, often in the early months of 2018.
