International school exchange programme

Students registered on the BA Law and LLB courses can apply in year two to be transferred onto one of our four-year degree courses with the opportunity to spend one year abroad during the third-year. It is a competitive process, but students who are successful can study in Europe through the Erasmus programme or at internationally in America, Australia, Canada, China, New Zealand or South East Asia. For countries outside Europe, you should apply via the School of Law through the International school exchange programme. For Law with European Law, you should apply via the School of Law through the Erasmus programme.
