## University-wide exchange programme

### Application deadline

Friday 10 January 2020

### Eligibility

BSc Mathematics (International Study): apply in second-year to spend full-year of third-year abroad.

BSc Mathematics, BSc Financial Mathematics and BSc Statistics: Apply in second year to study abroad for autumn semester of third-year.

MMath Mathematics: Apply in second-year to study abroad for autumn/spring semester of third-year OR apply in third-year to study abroad for autumn semester of fourth-year

Single honours with a minor subject and joint honours students must check with their other school/department to ensure that staff approve the exchange and programme of study. Minimum 60% average required to be considered.
