Registering with the University

You will need to <u>register online</u> before you arrive in Nottingham. Online registration is open now. You will also need to confirm your attendance in person. If you are living or studying on Sutton Bonington Campus you can complete in-person registration from Saturday 22 September onwards at the registration event in The Barn, Sutton Bonington Campus or at the Sutton Bonington Student Services Centre thereafter.

Students' Union welcome festival (University Park)

The welcome festival is one of the biggest events of the Welcome Week programme with hundreds of stalls, freebies and performances and it is free to attend. Starting on Monday 24 September and running for five days, the fair will feature a number of societies, sports, opportunities and local businesses.
