



Turing Grant – ThinkPacific (Fiji)

How much is the grant and what is the overall cost of the experience?

Students who are successful in being awarded a Turing Grant through this initiative will receive a grant of £2,170.

The overall cost of the experience is more than this so please be aware you will be required to self-fund (and/or fundraise) an amount of the cost yourself.

The overall cost of the experience can be broken down as follows:

- ThinkPacific Project Fee: £2,145 (this covers everything in-country e.g. accommodation, transport, weekend activities, beach resort activities)
- Flights: These will be booked by you the student. Estimated costs are £1,200 - £1,400
- Other costs: travel insurance, any required vaccinations if not available free via the NHS, spending money, travel to airport in UK etc.

How does the grant work and what do you need to use it for?

Students who are successful in the ThinkPacific recruitment process as outlined on this webpage will be informed of this outcome in January.

Successful students must accept the grant offer within 5 working days of the offer being made. If not accepted the offer will be rescinded and will be made to another successful student on a waiting/reserve list.

The grant payment will be made to students ASAP after this acceptance.

Students are then required to:

- (January) Pay a £195 registration fee (payment 1) to ThinkPacific to confirm your place, at this time you will also be able to confirm which project is your preference including dates of the experience.
- (January/early February) Book your flights. The earlier you are able to do this the more likely you are to find flights at a lower cost. As explained above anticipate this to be £1,200-£1,400.
- (Late February) Pay a second 'part-payment' (payment 2) of the ThinkPacific Fee of £450 in February
- The remaining element of the ThinkPacific fee (after payment 1 and 2) will be £1,500 must be paid by you no later than 6 weeks before you undertake the experience.

Terms and Conditions of the Grant

If a grant is paid to you and then you do not take up the opportunity for any reason, all funds will be repayable to the University. You must adhere to this condition, even if you are no

If an opportunity is cancelled, you choose not to undertake it for any reason, or if the opportunity is deferred to a later date the University cannot offer funding for this experience and all funds will be repayable to the University.
