Accommodation and Check-in Procedures

Accommodation is located in your hall of residence. All rooms are single study bedrooms, with a mixture of en-suite and shared bathroom facilities.

Keys are available from the hall of residence reception located in the entrance hall lobby from 3.00pm on the day of arrival. Rooms must be vacated and the keys returned to the porter's office by 10.00am on day of departure.

All guests are given a bedroom key and front door swipe card upon check in. The main doors will lock at midnight but access can be gained after this time by using the swipe card. Any guests who have not checked in by midnight are asked to use the free-phone at the entrance to the hall to call for security, who will let them into the hall of residence and give them their keys.

There will be a member of the hall team available from 08.00 until midnight.

Luggage storage is available in all halls of residence. Please ask at reception upon arrival/check-out for further information.

All bedrooms are equipped with bed linen, towels, toiletries and mini fridge.

Cafés

Boulevard Café in the Trent Building is open from 8.00am until 4.00pm Monday to Friday.
