

## **Food Oral Processing Conference Special Issues**

(July 2018, University of Nottingham, UK)

A special issue dedicated to the publication of research originating from the 5<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Food Oral Processing will be sponsored by the *Journal of Texture Studies*.

All oral and poster presenters are invited to submit manuscripts, either as a review, a research article, or a research note. All submitted conference manuscripts are subject to normal peer review process. **The submission deadline is 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018.** The issue is expected to be published December 2018.

### **Journal Aims & Scope**

The *Journal of Texture Studies* is an international peer-reviewed journal specialized on the texture, the structure, and the sensory perception of foods and consumer goods. It is a primary source on all of the sciences that relate to eating and sensory perception and the physical characterization of textural properties of food and other consumer products. The Journal is a leading source on the interface between food texture and viscosity and the health and well-being of people suffering from dysphagia, temporomandibular joint diseases, and other medical problems which affect eating and swallowing.

### **Submission Guidelines for Authors**

The following requirements are mandatory for all conference-related submissions:

- All papers must be submitted electronically via the Journal's online tracking system: <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/jts>.
- Submissions must be received by the stated deadline.
- Submissions must include at least **two** recommendations of suitable peer reviewers.
- Submissions must follow the Manuscript Style Guidelines, which can be found by visiting: [www.blackwellpublishing.com/jts](http://www.blackwellpublishing.com/jts) and clicking on 'Author Guidelines' link on the left-hand side of the page.

Due to the page limitation of the *Journal of Texture Studies*, all conference-related submissions cannot be guaranteed for inclusion in the Special Issues. However, conference papers that cannot be included in the Special Issues may still be published in subsequent issues of the journal.
