



John Field currently holds a visiting professorial fellowship at the University of Cologne, where he is working on a study of active citizenship and adult learning. He is also an emeritus professor at the University of Stirling and honorary professor at the University of Warwick.

He chairs Scotland's Learning Partnership, the national organization representing the interests of learners and providers in Scotland, and is a member of the research committee of the German Institute for Adult Education.

His research interests include social, historical and policy studies of further, higher, vocational and adult education. His most recent book is *Working Men's Bodies*, a study of British work camp systems before 1939.
