## REMEMBERING WARTIME THORESBY

All Our Stories is a wonderful opportunity to explore, share and celebrate the locality, focusing on the vivid stories from wartime Thoresby.

The landscape of Thoresby Park was shaped by the forestry and service industry until the Second World War, when various regiments trained and were billeted in the parklands. This significant event altered experiences, understandings and the war affected all; a moment which sparks vivid stories and memories to this day.

The Stonebridge Trust cares for detailed archives of the period, The Pierrepont Collection of social history paintings and it hosts the QRLNY Regimental Museum. Also archives of County, University of Nottingham and Kew hold pertinent records ready to be uncovered.

The Thoresby Volunteers will explore archives, digitise images to spark public interest, learn interview skills, edit oral histories, create a web resource and hold a celebratory exhibition in Thoresby Gallery.
