For examinations taken in the 2019/2020 academic period the following approach will be used

- Level 1 papers: 'Standard Only' - ONLY calculators from the lists may be used
- Level 2,3 & 4 papers: 'Interim' - Calculators functionally equivalent to those on the lists may be used provided the make & model are entered onto the cover of all answer booklets.

In future years, the following approach will be used.
