An abstract of no more than **250 words** should be submitted for review. Details should include:

- Names of authors/contributors
- Title of contribution
- Conference theme that best reflects the contribution (themes are detailed below)

Whilst there is no formal structure for the main body of the abstract, reviewers will be commenting on the following aspects of the contribution submission:

- Relevance to the conference theme
- Contribution to academic debate
- Link to teaching and learning
- Potential to further the development of innovative practice
- Potential to facilitate engagement of conference delegates
- Use of theoretical or conceptual frameworks that will interest or be of use to conference delegates
- Demonstration of scholarship within the field that conference delegates will benefit from
