The 2018 Teaching and Learning conference invites participants to engage in critical debate and discussion around the important theme of Digital Learning in Higher Education and the potential it has to:

- effectively prepare students for their lives beyond university
- support staff development and collaboration.

Contribution Formats

■ Papers

Individual or co-authored papers will be allocated a 30 minute slot (20 minutes for presentation and 10 for questions and discussion).

Papers that could be organised into a Symposium would also be welcomed.

■ Posters

These will be displayed throughout the conference and at a dedicated poster session when you'll be expected to stand by your poster and discuss it with colleagues. Prior to this session, you will be provided with the opportunity to briefly introduce your poster as part of the conference.

■ Round Table Discussion [30 minutes]

Contributions that generate discussion amongst participants and where feedback on potential journal submission is welcomed should be submitted for this section of the conference. Time allocated to individual contributions will be dependent on the volume of submissions for this section.

■ Workshops [60 minutes]

Interactive workshops designed to offer participants hands-on reflective, experiential and/or discursive activities in relation to the conference theme. The role of the workshop leader is to facilitate the activities of the participants rather than to make a lengthy presentation. Proposals should indicate how participants will be involved, the nature of the activities, and the anticipated time spent on each.
