Guidance for Holders of all Parking Permits

Permits entitle you to park on the University of Nottingham Campuses in a designated parking bay.

Full permits are virtual, and no physical permit is required to be displayed.

Occasional Use vouchers must be displayed alongside the permit disc. The vouchers can only be used for the vehicle they are assigned to. Unused vouchers are refundable and must be returned to Security Office, Hallward Library, University of Nottingham, University Park, Nottingham, NG7 2RD.

Students are not allowed to bring a motor vehicle to the University unless they meet the criteria for an 'Orange Zone' Permit.

Students are not allowed to use Pay and Display spaces except for the Sports Centre car parks for using Sports Centre facilities only.

Students who are the holders of 'Orange Zone' Permits are only allowed to park in the designated orange zone areas. For further information on car parking and orange zone map please follow the link below.

Holders of '**Resident**' Permits are only allowed to park at the residence or, if no parking facility is available, the nearest designated parking space.

Information for all Permit holders

The roads within the University sites, although private property, may be used by the public and therefore come within the definition of roads in the Road Traffic Acts. Accordingly, they are subject to the general law regulating road traffic. In addition, the University has traffic regulations which are applicable to all users of the University sites to promote the safety of drivers and pedestrians and to ensure the best use of limited parking space. You are not entitled to park:

- In a disabled bay, without an official blue badge
- On hatched areas
- Dangerously or causing an obstruction
- On double yellow lines
- On cycle lanes
- On grass or other landscaped areas
- In dedicated Visitors spaces, or in marked 'V' spaces, unless you Pay and Display or have a Yellow Visitors Day Permit
- In other reserved spaces
- In the reserved area at Trent East car park, unless authorised
- In the DHL (Lakeside) car parks at any time
- In Innovation Park (Jubilee) unless a UNIP Permit holder
- In staff areas or pay and display car parks if an 'Orange Zone' Permit Holder
- In the Cripps Health Centre spaces if a permit holder

N.B. Unauthorised parking will result in a Parking Charge Notice or a fine and/or vehicle permit being withdrawn.
