- The mandate of the National Land Commission (NLC) drawn from the Constitution of Kenya 2010, is to manage public land on behalf of the national and county governments.

Your current work/research

National Land Information Management System (NLIMS) Directorate

- NLIMS is designed to create, analyze, and publish land-based data such as parcel information, zoning, and ownership. NLC envisages the replacement of the current manual system of land administration and registration by an efficient, cost effective, user-friendly computerized system.

NLIMS main tasks are:

- Creation and strengthening of NLC's capacity to implement and maintain a computerized nationwide Land Information Management System
- Establishing a set of technical processes and procedures for the registration of rights and interests in land
- Automation of procedures in land and real estate transactions
- Establishment of mechanisms supporting automated management of parcel data within GIS environment
- Provision of a public access module allowing enquiries from general public on land information
