"Firms, workers, and inequality"

The Nottingham Centre for Research on <u>Globalisation and Economic Policy (GEP)</u> is organising the first workshop in Labour Economics, to be held at the University of Nottingham on 11-12 June 2024. The goal of the workshop is to bring together economists to present and discuss their ongoing research in Labour and to foster interaction between them. There will be a dedicated discussant for each paper.

The organising committee invites research submissions on any topic related to labour economics, including (but not limited) to: labour market impacts of migration and trade shocks; local labour markets and firms; gender gaps; labour market institutions; monopsony; inequality.

Submission guidelines and timetable: full papers or extended abstracts with main results should be submitted by 1 April 2024 using this <u>submission form</u>. Please note only one paper per person can be submitted. Decisions are expected to be communicated by 15 April 2024. Authors with accepted papers are expected to make their own travel arrangements. Accommodation will be covered for all presenters.

We especially welcome submissions from early career scholars as well as from scholars from underrepresented backgrounds.
