The Nottingham Centre for Research on [Globalisation and Economic Policy \(GEP\)](#) is organising its second annual workshop in Labour Economics, to be held at the University of Nottingham on 17-18 June 2025. The goal of the workshop is to bring together economists to present and discuss their ongoing research in Labour and to foster interaction between them. There will be a dedicated discussant for each paper.

The organising committee invites research submissions on any topic related to labour economics, including (but not limited) to: local labour markets and firms; human capital; gender gaps; migration; labour market impacts of trade shocks; labour market institutions; labour market power; technological change; labour mobility; wage inequality.

Accommodation in Nottingham will be covered for all presenters.

We especially welcome submissions from early career scholars as well as from scholars from underrepresented backgrounds.
