Aim: This Workshop will bring together economists working at the intersection of innovation, technology, competition, international trade, and related areas. We seek to create a welcoming environment where participants can receive valuable feedback and build a community around their research interests. This edition is hosted by University of Nottingham, and the inaugural edition was hosted by University of Sussex. The workshop will last one day, and **presentations** will be followed by a **Q&A** (30 minutes in total). Submissions from **researchers at an early stage** in their careers are particularly encouraged.
