Sabina: If you have 10-15 minutes spare you are welcome to speak to the pharmacist who can

advise you on the side effects. This is a free service, it won't cost you anything

Sabina: Yes its free the pharmacist will explain to you about the medicines for example what

the best time to take them and how to reduce the side effects from them

Patient: This is very good
