Support with Immigration Expenses



Loans for International Staff

The University of Nottingham has introduced an initiative to support International Staff (EU nationals and those from outside of the EU) and their immediate, accompanying family members with immigration related costs incurred during their employment at the University. This initiative is in the form of an interest free loan and is available to international staff across all job families.

Purpose of the loan

The intention of the loan is to support international staff and immediate accompanying family members with immigration related costs including;

Skilled Worker maintenance funds ***	Up to £1,270

*** University as Skilled Worker sponsors can certify maintenance funds for employees and their family members who are sponsored to work for University on a skilled worker visa (up to £1,270 for the employee and £285 for a partner, £315 for the first child and £200 for additional child).

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How to apply for the loan

The loan can be applied for using the application form provided, setting out the relevant immigration related costs that will be incurred and therefore the total amount requested. The maximum loan value will be £10,000.

How the loan will be paid

The loan will be paid in sterling into a UK bank account held in the name of the member of staff on the application form – this will be the same bank account into which the salary is paid.

Loan Repayment

The loan will be repaid as a salary deduction on a monthly basis in equal instalments and must be repaid within 3 years.

Should the employee leave the employment of the University of Nottingham, the remaining balance of the loan will be become repayable immediately with an automatic deduction from the final salary. If the salary amount is insufficient to cover the remaining debt, an invoice will be raised and the balance will become immediately due.

- (i) To repay the loan according to the timescales above through monthly salary deductions.
- (ii) In the event that I leave the employment of the University of Nottingham prior to full repayment of the loan through the monthly deductions, the remaining balance of the loan will be become repayable immediately with an automatic deduction from my final salary. If the salary amount is insufficient to cover the remaining debt, an invoice will be raised and the balance will become immediately due.

If the invoice is not paid, the University will seek settlement of the debt through all available channels including through debt collection specialists and the Courts and interest will be charged on a weekly basis at a rate of 3% above the bank of England base rate and will be automatically added to the outstanding debt.
