

COVID-19 Guidance for of House of Lords Events

- All visitors to the House of Lords venue are expected to wear face coverings on the Parliamentary Estate, at all times,
 unless seated in a room or inside a banqueting venue.
- If you need to leave the event room for any reason, please wear a face mask. For example, if you visit the toilet.
- Test and Trace QR codes are located at Cromwell Green Entrance and Black Rod's Garden Entrance. Please scan the
 QR code provided using the NHS COVID-19 app to 'check-in' before entering our venue. To reduce queuing times,
 we recommend downloading the app on your smartphone device prior to arrival. Thank you.
- Capacity of our event rooms may be limited due to COVID restrictions.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the public entrances and toilet facilities.
- We accept card payments only.
- We would encourage event organisers to ask their attendees to complete a rapid lateral flow test on the day of their
 event and retest two days later. Event organisers should encourage their guests to record test results using the NHS
 test and trace app. If they test positive, please instruct them to notify you. This specific guideline is not mandatory.
