M 2d. • Roger Daudson def <+> v Robert de Halum, executor of Henry del Howe's will <offered>. Plea: debt. Essonr: Richard Smyth.

PLEA • Robert del West def <offered> v William de Ludbiry pl <offered>. Plea: trespass. Essonr: Richard Stout. Plg: William ...

2 3d. • John Bower pl <offered> offered himself v Alan Bower def <put>. Plea: detinue. He unjustly detains a float (*flote*) worth ½m. On Mon after the feast of All Saints 30 Edward III (7 Nov 1356) Alan borrowed the float from John and [agreed] to release it by the hands of Richard Bower at [John's] wish; he was unwilling to release the float but unjustly detained it. Damages: 40d. Alan comes and defends [the force] and says he detains nothing from him. Inq.
