1 INQ IN RESPITE FOR DEFAULT [OF JURORS] Thomas de Wysow complains of William de Gresley. Plea: debt of 16d. which he mainperned to pay him for Richard Whytbrest on 20 Apr 10 Henry IV [1409]; he refused to render and still refuses. Damages: 10d. William, by Wyrsof his attorney, comes and defends [the force] and says he owes him nothing. Inq. (*hoc ponit se super inq*).

2 INQ IN RESPITE FOR DEFAULT [OF JURORS] William Leche complains of Robert Smyth. Plea: debt of 3s.4d. for wool (*lano*); he did not pay at Easter 10 Henry IV [7 Apr 1409]. Damages: 12d. Robert in his own person comes and defends [the force] and says he owes him nothing. Inq.

3 INQ IN RESPITE FOR DEFAULT [OF JURORS] William Payn, mercer (*merc*), complains of Adam de Bolton. Plea: trespass against the king's peace. That Adam on 12 June 11 Henry IV [1410] with force and arms entered the messuage (*accessit ad mesuagium*) where William lives and slashed (*delaceravit*) *suum leefsel*. Damages: 10s. He produces suit. Adam in his own person comes and defends [the force] and says he is not guilty. Inq.

4 [INQ] IN RESPITE FOR DEFAULT [OF JURORS] John del Heth complains of Robert Smyth. Plea: debt of 3s.6d. for cloth; he did not pay at Whitsun 10 Henry IV [26 May 1409]. Damages: 2s. Robert comes and defends [the force] and says he owes him nothing. Inq.

Edmund in his own person complains that Richard on Wed before Palm Sun 11 Henry IV [12 Mar 1410] with force and arms (staff and knife) raised up a ladder to his stone wall where Edmund lives, leaned it on his own wall and on his own soil and there destroyed his herbs of sage, hissop, parsley (*levavit quamdam skalam ad murum suum lapidem ubi ipse Edmund' manet et slandebat supra dictum murum suum et super solum suum proprium et ibidem destruxit herbas suas videlicet sawge isop parsely*) and other herbs of the garden and unroofed his wall and stripped it of coping stones (*et discopervit dictum murum suum ac innundavit¹ de cepertur*) with shovels, spades and other divers instruments. Damages: 100s. He produces suit. Richard in his own person comes and defends the force and protesting says he does not admit (*cog'*) the trespass to Edmund in the place where he is charged (*prefato Edmundo fact' in loco ubi supponit*). He says that John Hodyngs leased (*dimisit*) to Richard a messuage with a garden with the adjacent wall pertaining to the said messuage for a term of 7 years, which messuage and garden with wall John Hodyngs and all his predecessors occupied from ancient times (*ab antiquo tempore*). He seeks if any action ought to be held against him in this cause (*in hoc casu*). For the plea he says that Richard is not guilty of the trespass. Inq. Precept to the bailiffs to summon a jury of 12 to the next court. The parties charged and appeared. The jurors charged, chosen and sworn. The jurors say that Richard is guilty of the trespass but not against the peace and assess damages at 4d. Adjudged that Edmund should recover his damages of 4d. from Richard. Richard in mercy.
