He complains that William attached Richard by his body on Mon in Easter week 12 Henry IV [13 Apr 1411] and imprisoned him in Nottingham prison by virtue of a precept of the king's keepers of the peace within the vill and suburbs assigned by the king for divers trespasses, whereof it was adjudged before the said keepers of the peace by which trespass Richard offered (*se offerebat*) to furnish William sufficient pledgers and mainpernors who wished to mainpern him and offer themselves (*qui eum manucapere volobant et se offerebant*) to have Richard in his own person before the keepers of the peace on
