Our research will be disseminated via a number of workshops to discuss and disseminate the results from each research theme. All partners will ensure that their early career scientists (ECS) will contribute to their respective research themes. This will add value to both this programme and the ones through which funding is already secured, in addition to providing essential training and project legacy. Each partner will exchange at least one PhD student over the course of the project. We will also take advantage of the great level of expertise within the centre to provide mentoring for all ECS engaged in the programme. As part of our annual conference and reporting programme, we intend to run parallel training courses e.g. summer schools in relevant subject areas using the centre expertise in specialised areas such as image analysis, modelling and in transferable skills areas such as advanced data processing and presentation skills. We also plan to utilise the field trials as demonstration sites developed within the individual research themes and coincide training events with farmer training/dissemination days.
