

PPRG PhD Conference – Financial Assistance

We can offer financial assistance to a limited number of **PhD full-time students only**.

We are offering:

- 1 global south student up to £1,000 (GBP) towards the cost of their travel and accommodation (maximum 3 nights).
- 3 global north or south students up to £500 (GBP) each towards accommodation (maximum 3 nights).

The financial assistance will be in the form of a **reimbursement of applicable costs**. Successful applicants will need to complete a claim form and provide receipts or other evidence of expenditure.

Decisions will be made by a panel consisting of the conference organising committee: Professor La Chimia, Dr P Faustino and Miss S Robey.

The decision criteria will be based on the strength of the CV and the proposal. Where there is more than one student of equal preference, we will give priority to those who do not receive any travel funds, scholarship or stipend from their institution.

We will use the World Bank classification for global south (developing countries) and global north (developed countries).

How to apply for the conference with financial assistance

Please send:

- a two-page CV / resume
- the abstract of a proposal to participate in the conference.
- details of your university and supervisor(s) where you are registered to pursue a PhD full time.
- information about any travel funds, scholarship or stipend you receive/ can apply for from your institution.
