By car

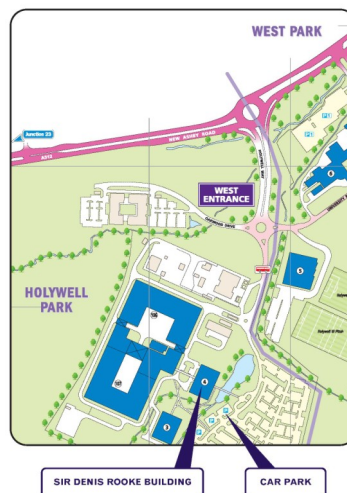
