

What is the effectiveness and cost-effectiveness of topical salicylic acid and cryotherapy for cutaneous (non-genital) warts - an economic decision mode?

This study used an economic model to estimate which of the most commonly used management options for cutaneous warts, ie: no treatment, salicylic acid or cryotherapy, was likely to be the most cost-effective. The model used existing published data, new data collected via focus groups, observation of practice and a questionnaire survey of patients and practitioners.
