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To reduce the impact and duration of illness on the lives of Frail Older People in Nottinghamshire, supporting them to stay in their home environment for as long as possible

What we've heard staff, patients and carers say we need as compared to now:

- "Better connection between health and social care"

- "Please recognise the cost efficiency of collaborative working across health and social care. Rehab staff in Clifton have to refer to Mary Potter to get social care and support, but sit in the same office as those whose help they need"  
From Clifton Cornerstone
- "We should aim for person-centred care rather than fitting the patient to the service"

- "Better respect for and understanding by health staff of the views and role of social care staff"

- Patients shouldn't be on a 'conveyor belt' – we should deal with problems properly"
