WHAT IS RETAKE?

This study tests whether individuals who receive Early Stroke Specific Vocational Rehabilitation alongside NHS rehabilitation are better able to return to work and maintain their job up to 12 months after stroke compared to people who only receive usual NHS care.

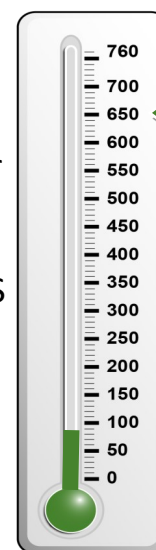


RECRUITMENT UPDATE
