Title of the presentation:

Preliminary observations on making treatment decisions in consultations between experienced hospice doctors and terminally ill patients Abstract (150 words maximum):

We draw on both analysis of video-recordings from an empirical study of palliative care consultations, and on findings from a systematic review of previous conversation analytic studies of healthcare decision-making, recommending, planning and goal setting in English language encounters. We first discuss ways of getting a conversation analytic grasp upon 'decisions', 'plans' and so on, given that these are not simply material and visible objects or projects. We illustrate the associated challenges using our hospice data. From our literature review, we overview what kinds of practices have been examined to date, and suggest some key gaps in knowledge. We then present

some related observations from our hospice data on how decisions, plans and so on get done or indexed in these interactions.

We aim to develop our own and others' clear thinking about the activities that are very much glossed when we term them recommending or making decisions.
