

HEADING TO THE TRAIN STATION?

Nottingham Express Transit (NET) runs a tram service that directly connects travellers to Nottingham train station. During peak times (7:00am – 9:00pm), there is a tram every 7-10 minutes; during off-peak times, trams run every 15 minutes until mid-night. **Trams heading to Hucknall will stop at Nottingham train station, so make sure you are standing on the correct platform.**

The nearest tram stop to the East Midlands Conference Centre has been marked on the map to the right. Live departure information and ticket machines can be found at each tram stop. **You must buy a ticket at the tram stop before getting on the tram, otherwise you could be fined £50.**

You can check for any disruptions to the service on the NET website (<https://www.thetram.net/>). If there are major disruptions to the service, there are several buses that can take you into Nottingham city centre; please refer to the Trent Barton and Nottingham City Transport (NCT) documentation for more information. Alternatively, use one of the listed taxi contacts below.

HEADING TO EAST MIDLANDS AIRPORT?

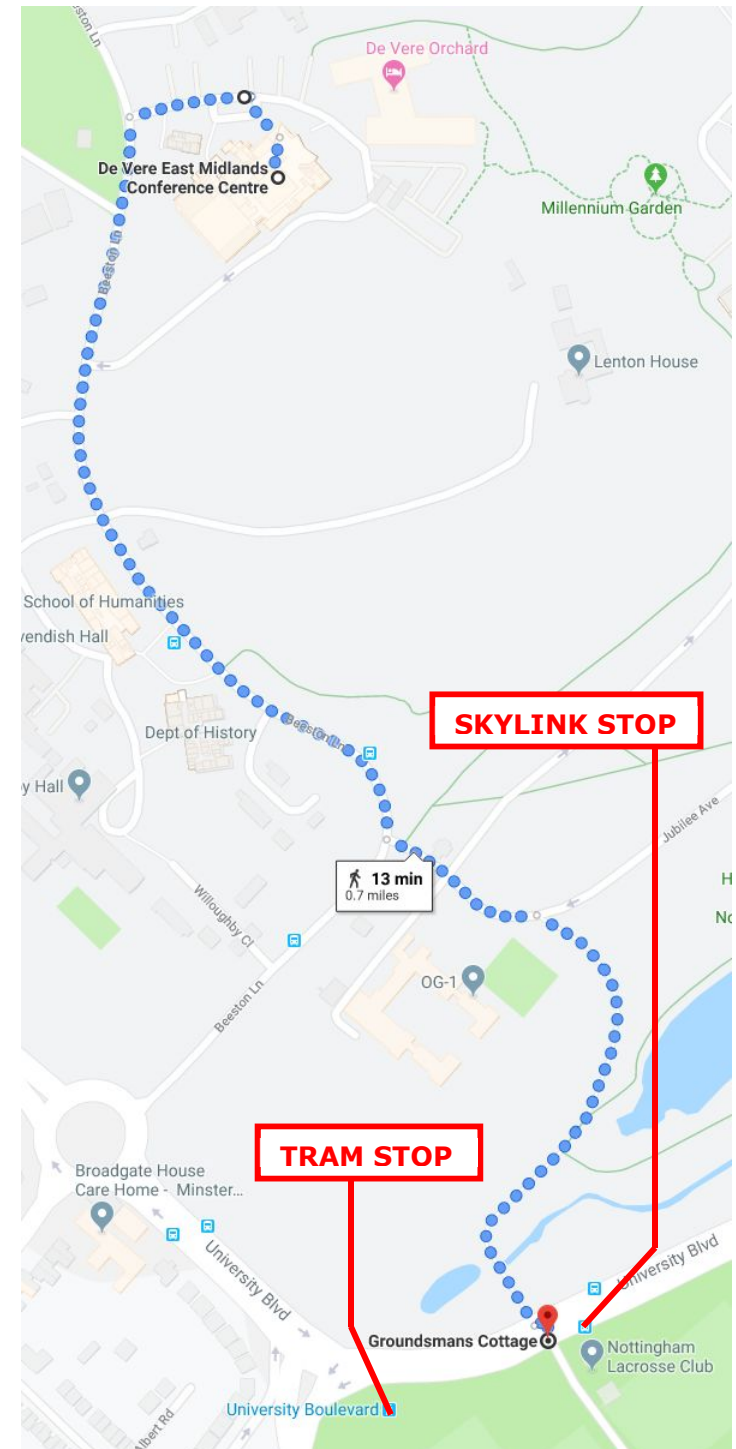
Skylink is a 24 hour bus service, run by Trent Barton, which connects travellers to East Midlands Airport. Three buses run every hour during the majority of the day, except between 7:00pm – 3:00am, where there is one bus per hour.

The closest bus stop to the East Midlands Conference Centre is marked on the map to the right. A single journey from this stop costs £4.30, which can be paid with cash (change can be given) or with a contactless card. 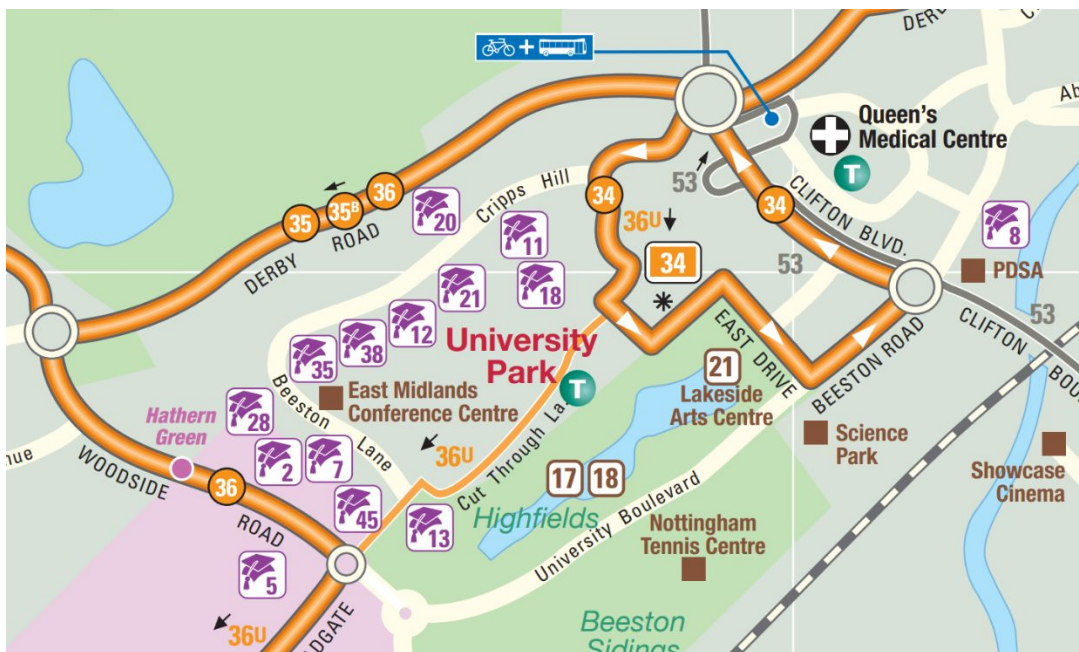
